Check out **Summerset Farm** this season.



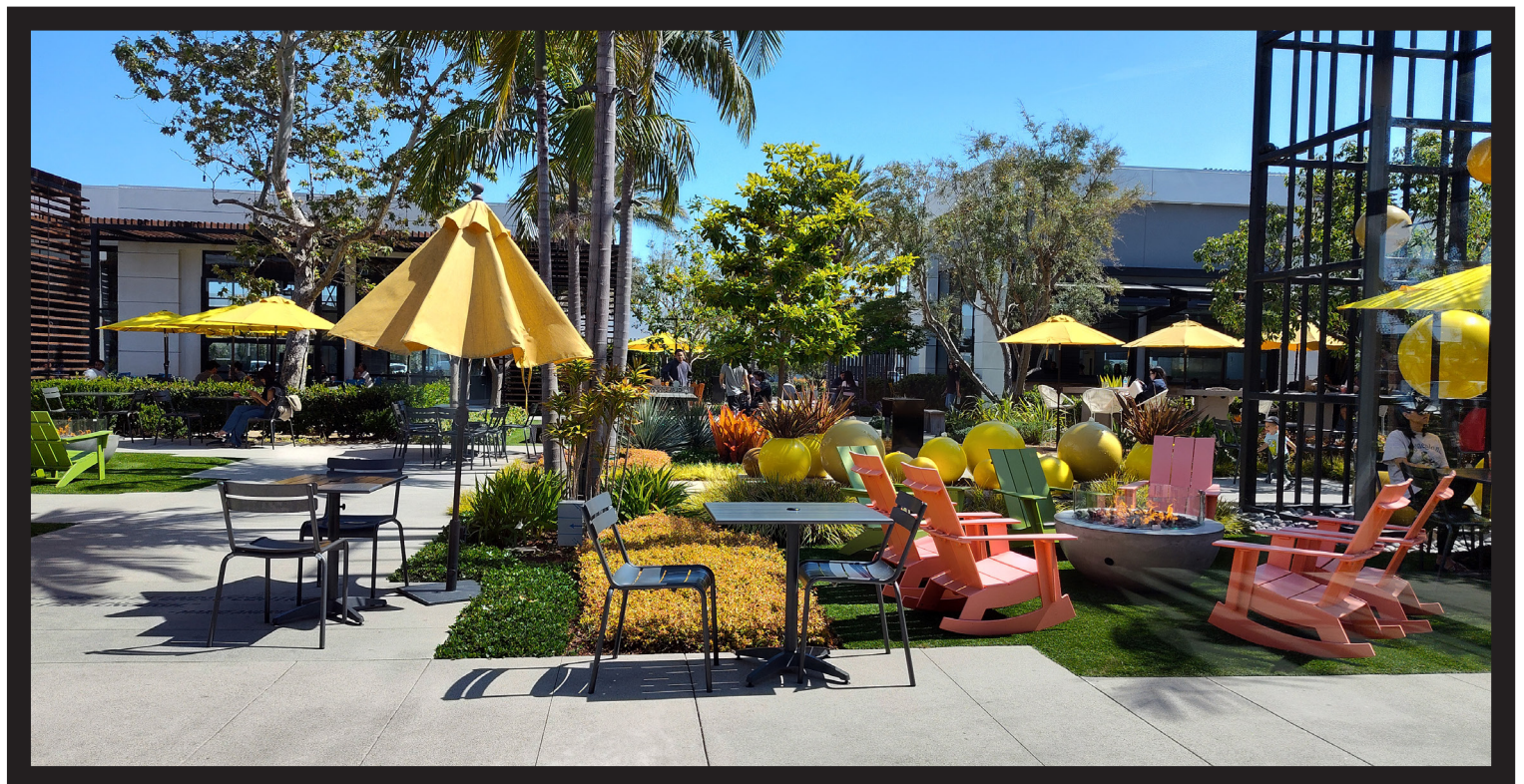
## The Enclave | Torrance's New Trendy Spot
